The academy is carrying out audio recording of almost every lecture being delivered by the faculty members, visiting faculty/guest speakers and that at the end of the

I am of the opinion, that instead of written compilation, it shall be easier for the Trainee Judicial Officers to keep record after the same has been re-laid upon the audio CD. However, some compilations made by the Academy at the instance of the faculty members, have already been supplied.

An effort has been made that on every Saturday a guest speaker is invited to share his/her thoughts with the Trainees vis-à-vis the subjects pertaining to law, judicial system and also the subjects other than the legal subjects.

In the first instance and on first Saturday – February 10, 2007, after the commencement of the course, **Hon'ble Mr. Justice J.S. Khehar**, President, Executive Committee had been kind enough to share his thoughts through the words of wisdom for the benefit of the Trainees. The talk given by his lordship has also been recorded but due to paucity of space and time it may not be possible to pen down the entire talk. Since then the Academy has been inviting the Hon'ble Judges, eminent Professors and Doctors and some other experts to give discourse to the Trainee Judicial Officers.
